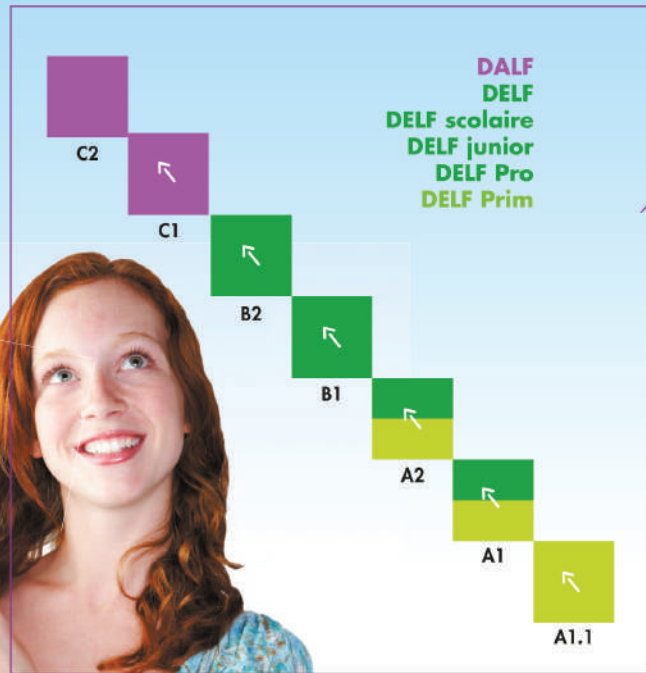


Diplomas for all levels

» A large range of diplomas of French as a foreign language are proposed by the national French ministry of education, to officially validate the level of French of students, from the first steps of learning up to the most advanced levels.

DELF JUNIOR SCOLAIRE

What if French could become a “plus” for your children?

» The DELF junior/scolaire is the diploma of studies in the French language delivered by the national French ministry of education.

It is universally recognised across the world.

» It is aimed at teenagers of secondary school age.

» The DELF junior/scolaire comes in 4 levels: A1, A2, B1 and B2 corresponding to the European Common Framework for Language Reference (CECRL).



A diploma for “la vie!”

» The diploma validates **communication skills in French as a foreign language**. The DELF is internationally recognised and valid for life!

» The DELF is an official diploma necessary to be able to **undertake studies in a French university**, a Grande Ecole or to work professionally in French.

An exam tailored to teenagers

» The testing **takes into account the lifestyle of a teenager** and their interests.

» The themes relate to **the environment of a teenager**, for example their family, their friends, their hobbies, middle school and high school.

» Your child’s teacher will let you know **which diploma they are able to follow** to take up a challenge without fear of failure.



4 tests, and “c’est bon!”

3 collective tests

» **Listening comprehension:** respond to questions regarding sound files.

» **Written comprehension:** respond to questions regarding written documents, for example, articles or advertisements.

» **Written production:** write a letter or a message, respond to mail.

1 individual test

» **Speaking production and interaction:** interact with an examiner.

» For each exercise, your child is in a real situation. The DELF is a diploma which evaluates their ability to communicate, both in speaking and writing, with French speakers.

» Each of the 4 parts is marked out of 25 points. With a total of 50 points out of 100, you get the DELF!
